PARVANI • BARODA • LARKANA

Nina Campbell introduces three new fabric collections; prints and embroideries, opulent weaves and velvets and co-ordinating small-scale weaves.



PARVANI

Nina Campbell celebrates her love of Indienne textiles. The PARVANI collection of decorative prints and embroideries is infused with characteristic features such as stylised florals with undulating stems and hand-block printed motifs. The designs are presented in Nina's signature palette along with fresh new colour combinations.

BARODA

A collection of opulent and decorative woven designs takes inspirations from textiles of the ancient silk route. Inventive weave techniques have been used to interpret these richly coloured designs.



LARKANA

A versatile collection of small-scale weave designs for upholstery. They provide the perfect complement to the decorative patterns in PARVANI and BARODA and to many of Nina Campbell's collections.

The collections and the individual designs are, as always, beautifully considered so that there is an endless choice for decorating schemes.

Integral to the Nina Campbell collections is a colour palette that has been developed with a decorator's eye, one that is constantly evolving so that new and existing designs work beautifully together.

This season the colourings synonymous with Indienne textiles, featured in earlier collections, are further developed. Nina also introduces fresh takes on russet with teal and ochre, and her take on neutrals, with soft sage, duck-egg, gold and bronze.
